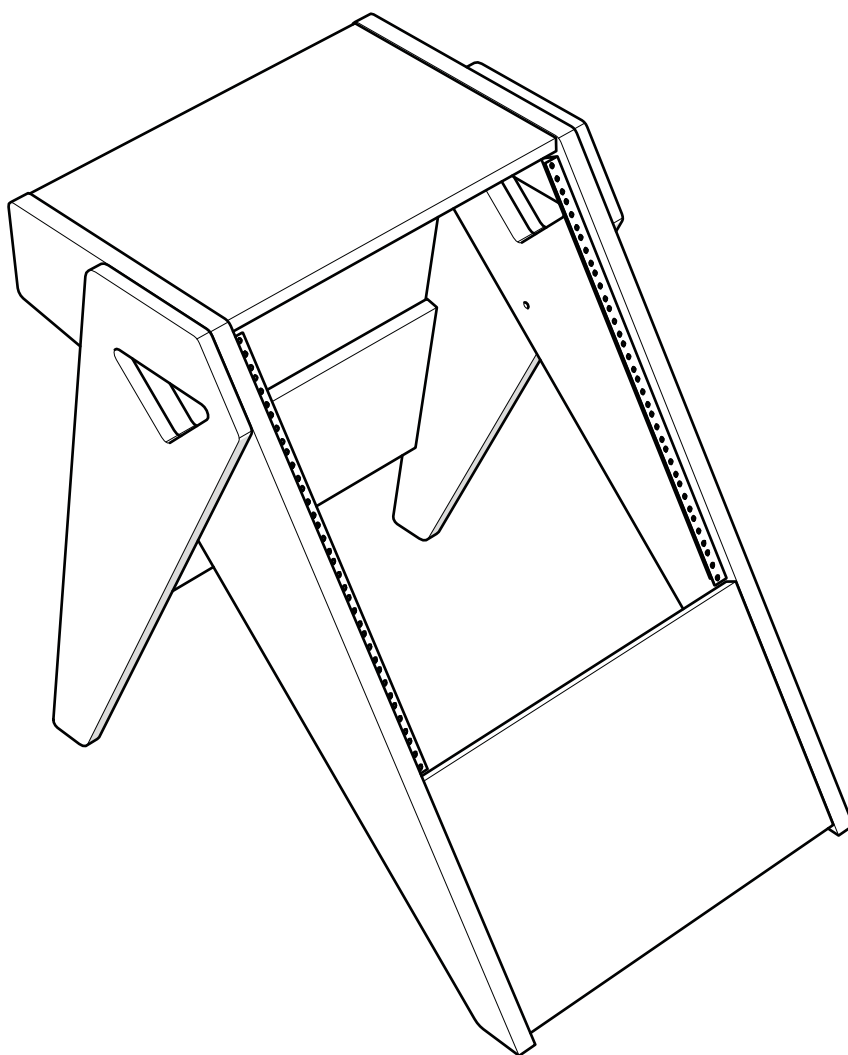

### Assembly Manual

Before you can enjoy the comfort of your new acquisition you need to assemble it.

Here is a general instruction on how to use the furniture assembly kits:

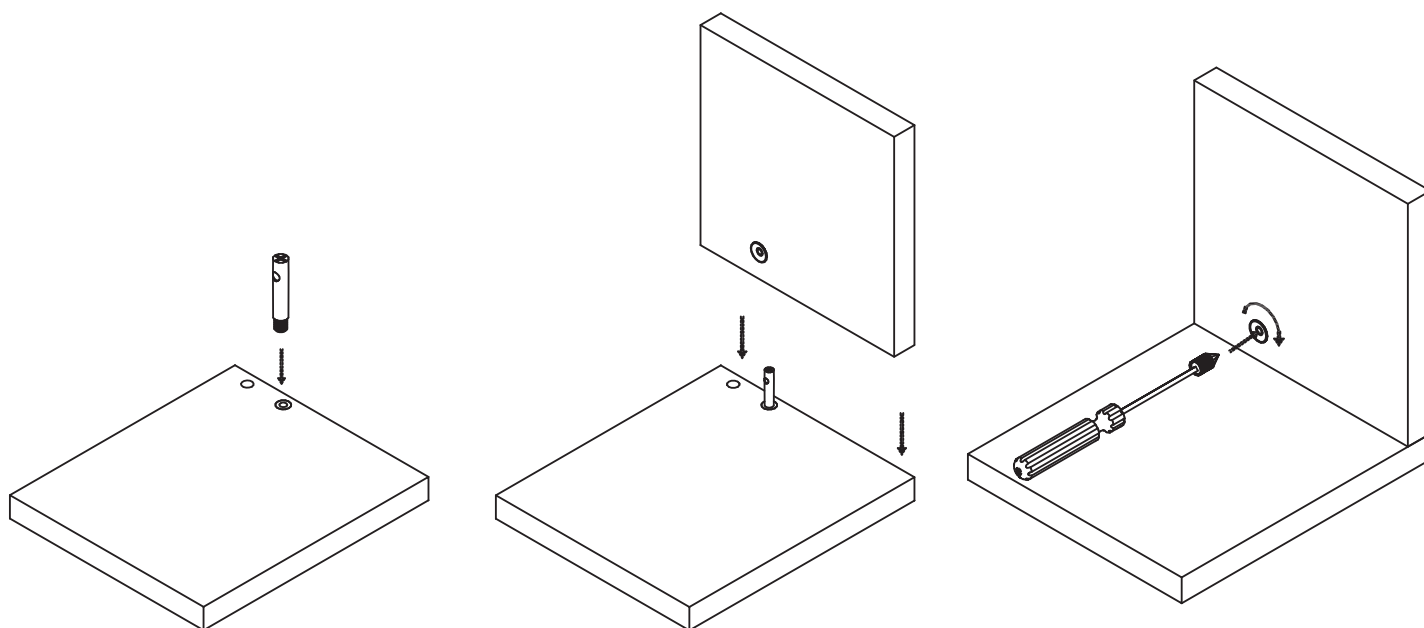
- 1) Insert and screw in the system bolt(s) into the socket(s) already present on the part(s) making sure the hole is at 90° from the edge
- 2) Assemble the connecting parts, inserting the bolts into the smaller holes in the connecting part, the bolt tip fitting into the side hole of the excenter until the hole in the bolt and the center hole of the excenter align
- 3) insert the locking screw into the excenter, and tighten with a cross screw driver all the way without using force!



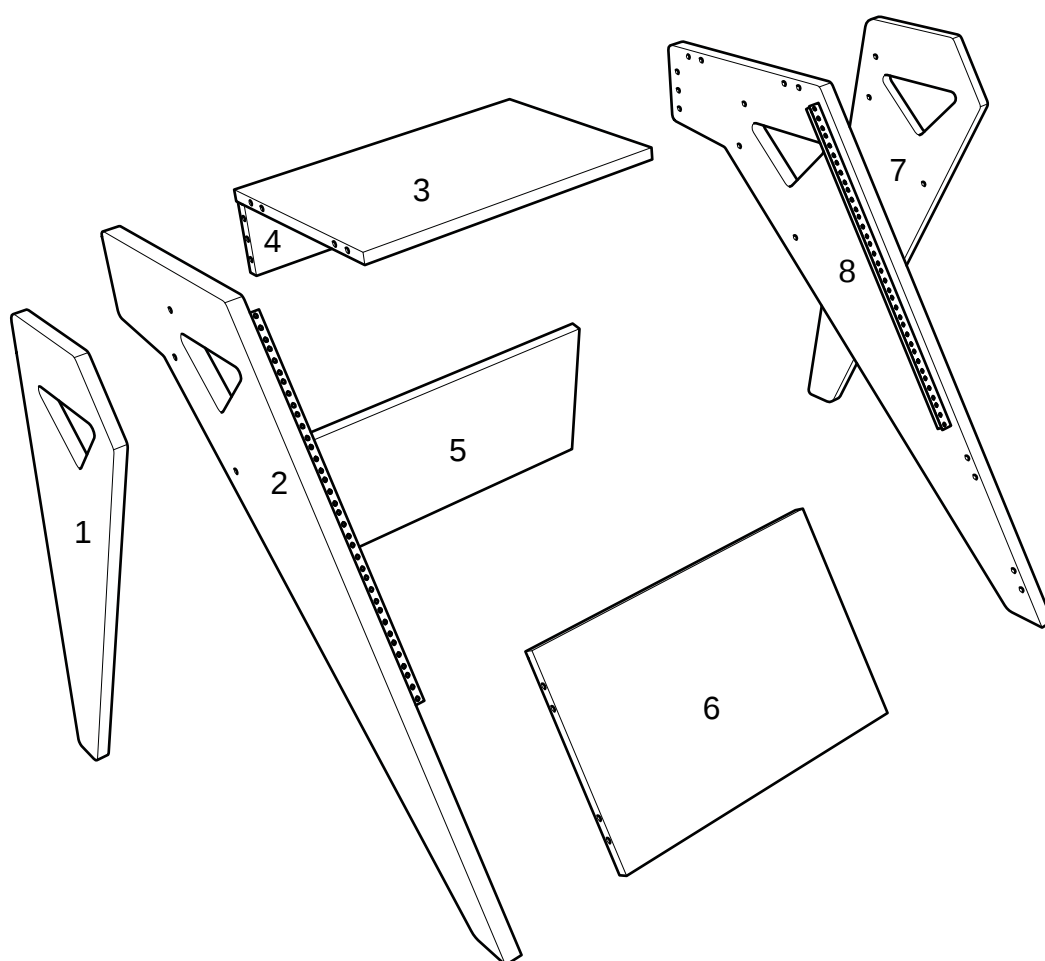
System bolt with hole



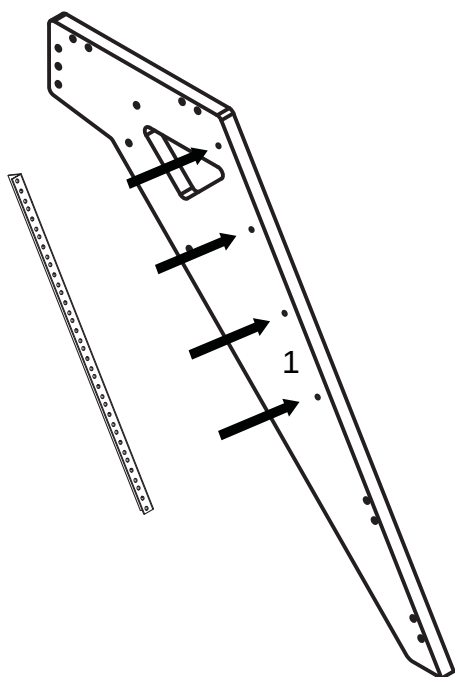
Locking screws



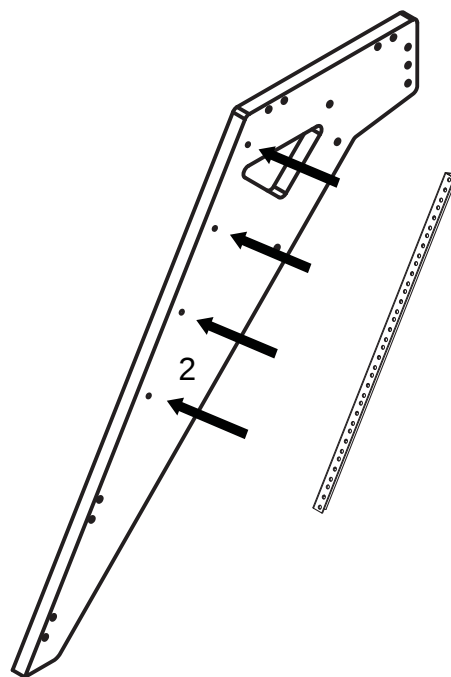

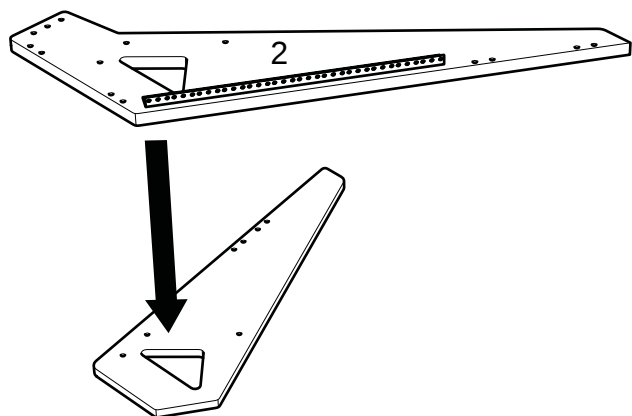

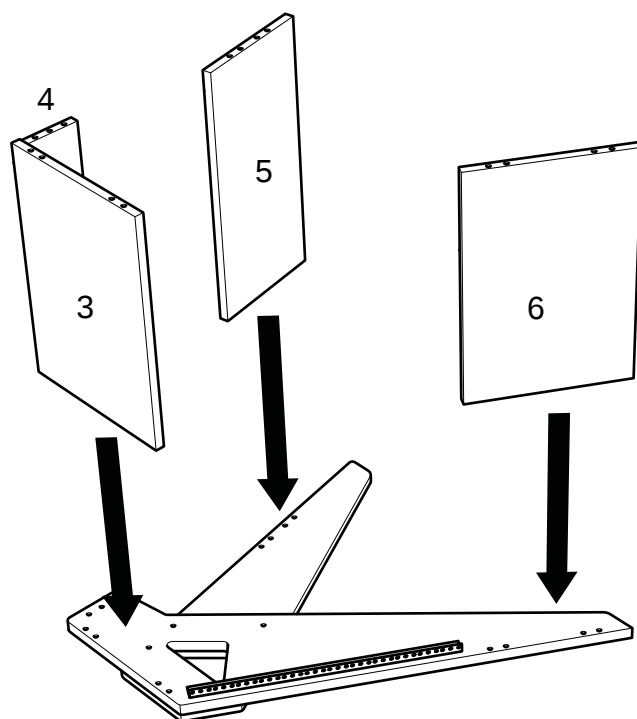
**Step 1** Fix rack bar with screws Type R



**Step 2** Fix rack bar with screws Type R

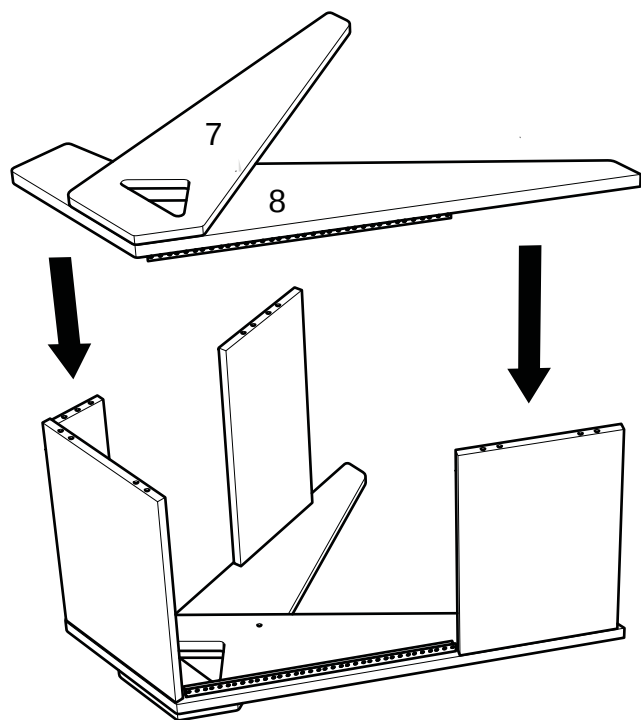


**Step 3** Repeat for parts no. 7 and 8

#### Packing list

Materials used:  
 - particleboard;  
 - metal hardware.

#### PACKING LIST

- 8 wood parts;
- 10 screws m4x16 (Type R);
- rack screws - 48;
- assembly kits - 14 pcs;
- M6 x 35 screws - 6 pcs .

#### Instructions for use and cleaning

- clean with a soft cloth, slightly humid or specific products for wood or lacquer;
- avoid the use of abrasive cleaners!

For assembly we recommend being at least two people.
